To honour the life and work of **Professor Jean-Marie Besson**

This is the seventeenth of an annual series of lectures to honour those who have made an outstanding contribution to the treatment and study of chronic pain. **Jean-Marie Besson** died in 2014. He was a founding member and later president (1996-99) of the International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP). He was an inspirational pain neuroscientist whose pioneering work included identification of descending pain control and the effect of morphine on the dorsal horn.

This year a short appreciation of his life and work will be given by **Anthony Dickenson**, Professor of Neuropharmacology in the Department of Neuroscience, Physiology and Pharmacology at University College London, who worked with, and was inspired by Professor Besson.

Professor Serge Perrot is a rheumatologist and a pain specialist. He currently heads the Pain Centre of Cochin Hospital, in Paris, France. He has coordinated more than 15 studies on rheumatology in the field of pain and he has published more than 150 papers. His interest is bridging Pain Medicine and Rheumatology.
